Effectiveness of Leadership & Management

1 Further strengthen leadership at all levels across the school:

- 1.1 Further develop senior leaders (Ma/En subject leaders further developing monitoring skills and all other leaders actively leading the monitoring of their subjects.)
- 1.2 Further develop & strengthen the role of the Governing Body.
- 1.3 Further strengthen pupils' positive contribution to whole school improvement through pupil leadership and pupil voice opportunities.
- 1.4 Ensure the quality of learning in Science is consistently challenging.
- 1.5 Improve presentation across the whole school, particularly handwriting.

Quality of Teaching, Learning & Assessment

- 2.1 Raise attainment & increase rates of progress by ensuring that the quality of teaching is at least good in all subjects and promotes greater independence, resilience and critical and creative thinking.

- 3.1 Further promote an environment with outstanding personal development, behaviour and safety.

Outcomes

- 4.1 Continue to raise standards of attainment across the school:
 - continue to increase proportion of pupils at higher standards, particularly PP chdn.
 - narrow the gap between boys and girls particularly in Reading & Writing.
- 4.2 Ensure at least good progress for all pupil groups across the whole school.
 - Increase progress rates for girls across the whole school and in particular girls in Maths across KS2.
 - Increase progress rates for PP chdn in Reading at KS2.
