I would like you to imagine that Ted Hughes has asked you to <a href="#">writing a sequel</a> to this book.</p> <p>Have a think about what the threat the Iron Man might have to face this time and whether he is able to come to the rescue. It may be that the world is being invaded by another creature or you may decide that the Iron Man could turn into a villain himself.
